***MV Transportation selected to operate Medicaid NET  
transportation in Palm Beach County, Florida***

**June 20, 2007** – The Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged (CTD) has selected MV Transportation as the new provider of Medicaid non-emergency transportation services for Palm Beach County, Florida.

With a start date of July 1, MV will manage the service and subcontract with other transportation providers to provide approximately 700 trips per day. The 6-month contract is worth \$2.28 million dollars.

MV has operated in Palm Beach County since 2005 as the contracted provider for the Palm Tran CONNECTION paratransit service.
