John B. Catoe Jr. Becomes Strategic Advisor to MV Transportation

Catoe joins MV Transportation’s existing Strategic Advisor and longtime transit professional, Shirley DeLibero in his new post. DeLibero is well-known in the industry for her many

achievements, including work for WMATA, DART in Dallas, New Jersey Transit and Houston Metro.

Originally from Washington, DC, Catoe began his public transportation career at the Orange County Transit District in the personnel department as an Employee Training and Development Administrator in 1979 and when he left, 17 years later, he was Director of Operations. When he left Orange County Transit he went on to head the transportation department in the City of Santa Monica, where he currently resides.
