## **MV Selected to Operate San Joaquin Regional Transit District “County” Services**

MV Transportation is pleased to announce the company has been selected by the San Joaquin Regional Transit District (SJRTD) as their new service provider for its “County” yard operations: Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter.

Beginning in September, MV will assume responsibility of the operations and maintenance from the Transit District for these services, which have been traditionally operated by the District. As the tough economy remains stagnant, many transit agencies across the country are choosing to outsource parts or all of their bus services to preserve as much service as possible.

According to the District, MV was the lowest responsible bidder for the \$27 million, five year contract. The services operate 2 million miles annually using 62 RTD buses. These “County” services link up with several other transit operations operated by MV in Lodi, Tracy and Manteca.

“We are excited about this new partnership with the RTD and we look forward to a long and successful relationship,” said Kevin Klika, MV’s Chief Operating Officer.
