Cal Marsella joins MV Transportation to lead Rail and Business Development Efforts

MV Transportation, Inc. is pleased to announce Clarence (“Cal”) W. Marsella, Jr. will join the company August 1 as Chief Development Officer and Chief Executive Officer of its new subsidiary, MV Rail.

In his position as Chief Development Officer, Marsella will be responsible for all business development and government relations activities for MV and its subsidiaries. Additionally, he will head the company’s efforts to promote and advocate for increases public-private contracting opportunities within the industry.

As CEO of MV Rail, Marsella will lead efforts to establish MV as global leader in the provision of rail passenger transportation. He will be responsible for building a team of experienced rail professionals and will lead the overall business development strategy for this new subsidiary.

“We are absolutely thrilled Cal has chosen to join the MV Team,” said Jon Monson, MV’s Chairman of the Board. “His public transit experience and wealth of knowledge is exactly what we need to lead our efforts in becoming a formidable passenger rail operator. Marsella, a 34-year transit veteran, has served as General Manager of the Denver Regional Transportation District (RTD) since August 1995. He manages 2500 employees, over 1000 privately contracted employees, and an annual operating budget of more than \$400 million. Under his leadership, the RTD successfully gained public support to build three new light rail lines on time and on budget, and includes RTD’s \$879 million light rail component of the \$1.67 billion T-REX light rail and highway project that opened November 17, 2006.

Mr. Marsella is a nationally-known private transportation expert who began his transportation career in the highway engineering division of the State of Connecticut



Department of Transportation in 1974. He then served as the Director of Transportation Services for the City of Hartford, Connecticut from 1976 through 1979. From 1979 through 1992, Cal served as the Chief of Contracted Services for Miami's Metro Dade Transit Agency. There, he was responsible for the development and management of all transit and paratransit services operated under contract to private sector service providers.

Marsella served as co-owner of Gulf Coast Paratransit, Inc. consultants in Fort Myers, Florida from 1992 to 1995.

Marsella was selected by the American Public Transportation Association as the Outstanding Public Transportation Manager in 2006, by the University of Colorado Real Estate Council as their 2006 Person of the Year, and by Colorado Association of State Transportation Agencies as the Transportation Professional of the Year in 2000. During his tenure at RTD, the agency was named the Outstanding Transportation Agency in North America in 2003 and 2008.

He serves on the National Academy of Sciences Transportation Research Board, and was a member of the Board of Directors of the Intermodal Transportation Research Institute at the University of Denver. He regularly guest lectures at the University of Denver and the University of Colorado Masters Degree programs in Transportation and Public Administration, and is in demand as a speaker on public-private partnerships.

Marsella holds a Masters Degree in Public Affairs and a Bachelor of Arts Degree, both from the University of Connecticut. Cal commutes by bus each day from his home in Louisville, where he resides with his wife Sheri and their children.
