MV's Community Relations Manager Reappointed by Governor

The Florida Rehabilitation Council for the Blind assists in the planning and development of statewide rehabilitation programs and services for blind individuals. It also recommends improvements to existing programs and services for Florida residents with visual impairments. The council is crucial to the ongoing development of services that provide independence and freedom for visually impaired Floridians.

"Dwight has done an excellent job as a Consumer Advocate for MV, and as a member of the Florida Rehabilitation Council for the Blind," said Alex Lodde, MV's Founder and Chief Executive Officer. "I plan to keep an eye on the challenges facing the blind and visually impaired who participate in the Vocational Rehabilitation Programs, with particular emphasis on what impacts their success in gaining career opportunities," said Sayer. "One of the major challenges is reliable transportation services. We have to be able to get them to their job for the rehabilitation process to work."
