

MV Transportation, Inc. renews paratransit contract with the City of Vallejo

July 7, 2008 (Vallejo, California) -- On June 24 the Vallejo City Council once again approved the award of the Vallejo Runabout paratransit service to MV Transportation, Inc. The three-year, \$2.7 million contract (with three, two-year options) began on July 1.

MV's proposal offered the City an alternative option to save money without limiting the availability of services to the senior and disabled community of Vallejo. Although MV was the sole bidder in this procurement, the winning proposal still offered significant savings based on the large presence of MV's operations in the region.

The City of Vallejo has contracted with MV to provide these services for 13 years; in addition, the Vallejo Citizens Transit Corporation, an MV subsidiary, has operated the fixed route service for 52 years.

Kevin Klika, president of MV's West Group stated, "Words cannot describe how pleased I am about this award. Back in 1995, when MV started this contract, we only had a handful of locations. Vallejo is part of our history and culture, and I hope that MV is becoming a part of theirs."

The Runabout is a curb-to-curb complimentary paratransit service that operates seven days a week. MV operates and maintains the City owned fleet of 13 vehicles. Last year we transported more than 34,000 passengers through the Runabout services.

Based in Fairfield, California, MV is the largest private provider of paratransit services and the largest privately-owned transportation contracting firm in the U.S. The company employs more than 11,500 dedicated transit professionals and operates more than 180 paratransit, fixed-route, shuttle and Medicaid contracts in 24 states and British Columbia, Canada.

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
