

MV Transportation, Inc. retains contract to operate Wilson County Transportation Services

July 7, 2008 (Wilson, North Carolina) -- MV has been awarded a contract to continue operation of the Wilson County Transportation Services in Wilson, North Carolina.

Under the terms of this three year agreement (with two additional, one-year options), MV will provide curb-to-curb demand response service for 7,500 passengers monthly, using 14 County provided buses. This service is funded in part by the Wilson County Human Services Agency. MV coordinates transportation for approximately 13 agencies throughout the County, and is also responsible for fleet maintenance under this contract.

MV acquired this contract from AppleBus in 2007, and since that time we have worked closely with the County to enhance the service through improved customer service and increased on-time performance.

Upon learning of MV's award, Keith Whalen, East Group President stated, "It is an honor to be selected to continue these important services. Our Wilson County team has been a wonderful group to work with, and they have done an extraordinary job. Being asked to represent the Wilson County Transportation Services for another five years is a very high compliment."
