

MV Transportation, Inc. retains transportation contracts for the Cities of Beverly Hills and West Hollywood.

July 7, 2008 (Beverly Hills and West Hollywood, California) – After a joint competitive procurement, the Cities of Beverly Hills and West Hollywood have each selected to retain MV as their transportation contractor.

Although each City will execute a separate contract for these services, the Cities jointly issued an RFP for fixed route and demand response services. Their combined effort allowed the cities to obtain the best service at the best price, thus choosing MV.

On May 19 the West Hollywood City Council approved the award of a \$10.1 million contract. Two weeks later the Beverly Hills City Council approved the award of a \$4.6 million contract to MV. Each of the seven-year base term (with three, one-year options) contracts began July 1.

MV's proposal included installation of significant technology for each of the City's services; including Trapeze scheduling software, and a number of MV's proprietary monitoring and reporting tools. In addition, each vehicle will be equipped with DriveCam recording units and GPS enabled Sprint phones to enhance performance monitoring.

Also included in MV's proposal is the transition into a new facility, which is significantly closer to each service area, and will reduce. MV will continue to maintain 12 vehicles for the City of West Hollywood, and seven vehicles (including two trolleys) for the City of Beverly Hills.

"Five years ago, MV's contracts with the Cities of Beverly Hills and West Hollywood marked the start of our significant expansion in Southern California. But our work is not done – I am excited to build on our existing relationships and work hand in hand with the Cities to improve these services," said Kevin Klika, Western Group President.
