On Monday, June 1, the ASI Board approved a five year contract with MV to continue as its service provider, and MV will provide all new vehicles which will continue to improve the level of service provided to our overflow customers.

This service is provided with five dedicated drivers who coordinate directly with ASI's command center to provide overflow relief for service providers in Los Angeles County. When the originally assigned service provider has been unable to provide a trip, or is running late, MV becomes responsible for providing that trip.

“We perform a critically important service here as our drivers must show the highest levels of customer service to help defuse any situation caused by riders being delayed,” said Kevin Klika, MV's Chief Operating Officer. “I am thrilled that we will continue to provide this vital service.”
