MV Transportation, Inc. successfully retains Vallejo Citizens Transit Corporation contract

Vallejo, CA – (January 28, 2008) The City Council of Vallejo recently voted unanimously to retain MV Transportation, Inc. as the manager of the Vallejo Citizens Transit Corporation (VCTC).

Under the terms of the new 10-year contract (three years with seven option years), MV will continue to operate the agency's fixed-route services. The contract has annual revenues of more than \$7 million, and employs more than 60 drivers utilizing 50 transit coaches.

"We are very excited to continue our successful operation in the City of Vallejo and look forward to building upon the great relationship we share with our riders and the city's leaders," said Kevin Klika, President of MV's West Coast Operations.

VCTC, a subsidiary of MV since 2005, has operated the City's public transportation services for more than 50 years. Formed by several community leaders in 1956 to save the City's bus system, VCTC is one of the oldest bus companies in the United States.

Based in Fairfield, California, MV is the largest private provider of paratransit services and the largest privately-owned transportation contracting firm in the United States. The company employs more than 11,000 dedicated transit professionals and operates more than 180 paratransit, fixed-route, shuttle and Medicaid contracts in 24 states and the District of Columbia.
