## **MV Transportation, Inc. selected to operate Gold Coast Transit paratransit services**

MV Transportation, Inc. is pleased to announce the company has been selected to operate the paratransit services for Gold Coast Transit in Oxnard, California.

Under the terms of the five-year, with five one-year options, contract, MV will provide curb-to-curb demand response transportation services to persons with disabilities and seniors. This 21-bus operation begins on July 1.

The service area includes the cities of Ojai, Oxnard, Port Hueneme and Ventura, as well as unincorporated El Rio, Nyeland Acres, Saticoy, Montalvo and the Highway 33 corridor between San Buenaventura and Ojai. This service was previously operated by Laidlaw, and most recently First Transit, for 14 years.

“This is a great win for our team as we seek to expand our operations throughout Southern California,” said Kevin Klika, President of MV’s West Coast Operations. “We offer higher wages and a higher level of benefits to the employees, which I am sure will translate into improved service quality.”
