**Napa County chooses MV Transportation, Inc.  
to operate community bus services  
*MV selected over incumbent Veolia***

The Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency Board of Directors voted Wednesday to award the Napa County Transit Services to MV Transportation.

Under the terms of the six-year contract, with an additional four year extension, MV will assume responsibility of the county's fixed-route, Dial-A-Ride and a new commuter bus service on July 1. The county will pay MV approximately \$4 million annually to operate the 53 vehicle transit service.

"We are extremely pleased to be selected as the new provider of it community bus services," said Kevin Klika, President of MV's West Coast Operations. "We are even more thrilled that the selection committee recognized MV offers an experienced leadership team with a reputation for providing quality service and exceptional corporate support. This win is even more gratifying because Napa is practically in our backyard."

MV's proposed General Manager, Mr. John Siragusa, received a perfect rating from the NCPTA staff. According to staff's recommendation, MV's national clients who were contacted as references all indicated that "MV has assembled experienced professionals for each local management team at each site and is responsive to the needs of clients and community."

Based in Fairfield, California, MV operates more than 180 transit contracts in 24 states, several of which are located throughout California. Locally, MV operates buses services in Fairfield, Vallejo, Pinole, Elk Grove, Livermore and San Mateo County. MV employees more than 11,000 transit professional nationwide and operated nearly 7,000 vehicles.

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
