(Lodi, CA --- September 8, 2008) The City of Lodi has again selected MV Transportation, Inc. to manage and operate the Grape Line’s fixed route, paratransit and dial-a-ride services – an \$11 million contract.

Under the terms of the five-year contract, MV will provide service to an annual ridership of more than 380,000, while traveling nearly 306,000 miles each year. Following a successful five years as the contractor of these services, MV began the new contract with the City of Lodi on July 1.
