MV Transportation, Inc. wins \$46 million contract in Los Angeles

(Los Angeles, CA – November 19, 2008) MV Transportation, Inc. has been unanimously chosen by the Los Angeles City Council to operate and manage the Los Angeles Department of Transportation's Region 2 Commuter Express system – a service providing transit to many members of the downtown workforce.

"MV is very proud of this win, and we eagerly look forward to partnering once again with the LADOT," said Kevin Klika, MV's Chief Operating Officer. "We will enhance these services throughout the greater Los Angeles area through technological advancements, a strong maintenance team, and our trademark focus on safety."

Under the terms of the 5-year contract, MV will begin service provision on January 1, 2009, through the use of 75 commuter coaches and large transit buses. Utilizing a staff of more than 90, MV will implement new technology to improve service, including DriveCam, Automated Passenger Updates, and the company's Fixed Route On-Time Performance Tracker.

The Region 2 Commuter Express services provide early morning and evening, non-stop and limited services between residential areas and major work centers. The fixed route transit services are provided throughout the San Fernando Valley, San Gabriel Valley, Simi Valley, West Los Angeles and downtown.
