MV Transportation, Inc. retains \$55 million contract in Baltimore

(Baltimore, MD --- September 8, 2008) The Maryland Transit Administration has again selected MV Transportation, Inc. to manage and operate the Mobility paratransit services in the City of Baltimore – a \$55 million contract.

Under the terms of the six-year contract, MV will provide service to an annual ridership of 285,000 – provided through the operation of a fleet that will soon reach 170 vehicles. MV began the new contract with the MTA on September 1.

“We are excited to continue this partnership with the MTA,” said Alex Lodde, MV’s Founder and Chief Executive Officer. “Mobility has been an integral part of serving the senior and disabled community of the Baltimore metropolitan area, and we are proud to be a part of this service.”

Over the past six years, MV worked with the MTA to increase safety and on-time performance for the Mobility services. Moving into the next contract term, MV will focus on the company’s ability to adapt to a changing service environment through increased flexibility and capacity for the assumption of additional routes. As a training tool and a safety enhancement, MV will also install the DriveCam video system on 100 percent of the fleet.

This contract is one of five operated by MV in Maryland. MV operates and manages transportation services in the cities of Silver Spring, Beltsville, Capitol Heights and Waldorf – and the company’s most recent win in Baltimore.

Based in Fairfield, California, MV is the largest private provider of paratransit services and the largest privately-owned transportation contracting firm in the United States. The company employs more than 12,000 dedicated transit professionals and operates more than 190 paratransit, fixed-route, shuttle and Medicaid contracts in 24 states.
